



# Early Entry Program


### Last year

- Over 1500 early offers issued to Year 12 students.
- 94% of applicants successful.
- In 2024 we introduced folio submission for the Bachelor of Design (Fashion).
- Federal and state governments require all universities to delay early offer release until September.
- 80 early offer holders attended tailored tours of Swinburne's graduate exhibitions, GradX (Architecture and Design) and CapEx (Engineering, IT and Science).

## This year

- Retaining the same application process as last year, with the next gen\_now questionnaire and School Recommendation form.
- Keep an eye out for more opportunities for Early Entry Program applicants to experience Swinburne earlier this year.

# Scholarships

- In 2024, we removed the administrative burden on students applying for scholarships.
- Scholarship offers were made to 80 students eligible for our Access scholarships.


## Resources for schools
